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ABOUT US

ProsArt Ballet Junior is a vocational and certificate-granting training program for classical and contemporary dancers wishing to fully commit to an artistic career.

Founded by Antoine Pros and Leona Sivoš, professional dancers and educators, the program was born from their experience on stage, in companies, and in teaching. Their shared vision was to create a structured, rigorous, and deeply human working environment, allowing dancers to develop a solid technique, a strong artistic identity, and true professional autonomy.

Inspired by the actual operations of a professional company, ProsArt Ballet Junior places artistic excellence, stage experience, and the dancer's well-being at the heart of its pedagogy. The program is distinguished by the quality of its instruction and its international artistic collaborations. Between 5 and 10 performances are organized per season.



THE TRAINING

ProsArt Ballet Junior is a vocational and certificate-granting training program, designed to provide concrete support for dancers as they transition into the professional world.

The program offers full immersion into the reality of the dance profession: daily classes, rehearsals, repertoire, choreographic creations, performances, career coaching, and meetings with renowned artists.

The goal is to train versatile, mindful, and technically solid artists who are capable of meeting the demands of the professional world.

PROGRAM

The program runs from October to June. The days are structured based on the model of a professional company and are organized around several complementary areas.

Fundamentals of the professional dancer

Classical technique, contemporary technique, musicality, precision, coordination.

Professional and stage experience

Classical and contemporary repertoire, choreographic creations, rehearsals, performances, and artistic projects.

Physical and mental preparation

Muscle strengthening, Pilates, yoga, body awareness, injury prevention, stress management.

ProsArt Ballet Certification

Continuous assessment, validation of acquired skills, and certification upon completion of the program.

Career development

Audition preparation, artistic CV, professional photos and videos, career strategy.

Born in Albi, he began his dance training under Line Jenny Neel before attending the Conservatories of Toulouse and Marseille. As a scholarship recipient at the *Prix de Lausanne*, he went on to further his training at the *Houston Ballet Academy*. He then embarked on an international career, performing with the *Colorado Ballet*, the *Thüringen Ballet*, the *National Ballet of Brno*, the *English National Ballet*, and the *Israel Ballet* (Ballet National de Tel-Aviv). He performed both corps de ballet and soloist roles in works by M. Petipa, J. Kylián, U. Scholz, K. Pastor, R. North, and many others. Since 2016, he has focused on pedagogy, choreography, and well-being. He is now Artistic Director of *ProsArt Ballet* in Albi.



Leona Sivoš

**Artistic Director,
Coordinator, Ballet Mistress
and Choreographer**

Trained at the Zagreb School of Classical Dance, and a semi-finalist at the *Prix de Lausanne* in 2007, she continued her studies at the *Munich Academy*, graduating in 2009. She began an international career with the *Thuringian Ballet*, then with the *Mönchengladbach and Krefeld Theatre*, the *Croatian National Theatre Split*, and the *Compañía Nacional de Danza* in Madrid, under the direction of José Carlos Martínez. There, she performed both corps de ballet and solo roles in works by renowned choreographers such as M. Petipa, G. Balanchine, W. Forsythe, O. Naharin, J. Kylián, and N. Duato, among others. Since 2023, she has also been the coordinator and teaching assistant for the *ProsArt Ballet* training program in Albi.

Ballet coach

She began her classical dance training at the George Berard Dance School in Mexico, where she acquired the foundations of the *Vaganova* technique. At the age of 15, she participated in the *Attitude* dance competition and won a scholarship to join the *Ballet-Études* program in Lyon. She then returned to Mexico to continue her training with Hector Hernandez before coming back to France, where she joined the *École Nationale Supérieure de Danse de Marseille*. After passing her *Technical Aptitude Exam*, she joined Pascal Touzeau's company in Bordeaux, where she also danced for several choreographers, including Sandra Valentini, Sohrâb Chitan, Anthony Egea...

GUEST ARTISTS & INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIONS

One of the essential pillars of ProsArt Ballet rests on the quality, renown and diversity of the artists with whom the dancers are led to work.

Each season, the program collaborates with renowned choreographers, teachers, ballet masters and company directors from international stages and companies. These artists are involved in courses, masterclasses, creations, repertoire, rehearsals and stage projects.

This approach allows dancers to:

- be exposed to **varied aesthetics and techniques**,
- gain a concrete understanding of the **demands of the professional world**,
- immerse themselves in an **international artistic network**,
- benefit from **constantly renewed**, demanding training connected to current dance trends.

CAREER PATHS

The comprehensive training offered by ProsArt Ballet Junior opens many doors in the world of live performance. Our students can join prestigious ballet companies and theaters, participate in musical shows or choreographic productions, or choose the path of freelance performing arts to fully live their passion. Some also pursue teaching or artistic transmission, while others join collaborative projects or emerging companies. This diversity of paths reflects the versatility and professional preparation acquired within our program, giving each student all the tools to transform their talent into a concrete artistic career.

Upon completion of the training, the dancers are prepared to:

- To attend national and international auditions,
- to join professional companies,
- develop a career as a dancer, performer, or freelance artist,
- participate in choreographic projects and stage productions.

The training emphasizes autonomy, versatility and the realities of the profession.

PRICING & FINANCING

Total cost of the training: €7,800
For a training period from October to June

Payment in installments is possible upon request.

This price includes :

- All courses and workshops,
- choreographic projects and performances,
- the educational and artistic supervision,
- the costumes,
- professional photos and videos,
- career coaching (CV, photos, videos, auditions),
- ongoing assessment and certification *ProsArt Ballet*.

No hidden fees: the training is designed as a complete professional artistic experience.

SCHOLARSHIPS

There is no automatic institutional funding for this program.

However, **scholarships may be awarded by the program director, depending on the applicant's artistic potential, background, and personal circumstances.**

These scholarships can cover up to 50% of the total cost of the program.

Scholarships may be partial or exceptional. All scholarship applications must be accompanied by a complete artistic portfolio and a letter of motivation, clearly explaining the reasons for the application, the dancer's background, and their professional goals.

Applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis, subject to availability.

For applicants not receiving a scholarship, ProsArt may cover visa costs if necessary.





LIFE IN ALBI

Located in Albi, a UNESCO World Heritage city, ProsArt Ballet offers an ideal environment for artistic training:

- A cultural city on a human scale.
- Quality of life and preserved natural environment.
- Cost of living and affordable housing, compared to major European capitals.
- Partner accommodation options.
- Close to Toulouse (45 min)
- Easy access by train.

This context allows the dancers to fully dedicate themselves to their training in optimal conditions, both artistic and personal.

INSTITUTIONAL PARTNERSHIPS

Over the years, ProsArt has forged links with major cultural venues in Albi such as the Scène Nationale and L'Athnanor. It also regularly receives support from the Albi town hall.
